DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I've always admired films that use humor as a tool to address serious issues and social disparities—dark comedies that fill the room with laughter but at the end leave the audience questioning, provoking thought and discussion about the film's subject. That was what I wanted for ,One Fine Sundae'. I wanted to make people laugh, but at the same time bring up the issues of gender inequity and hostile work environment (the central motifs of this short) as well.

The initial inspiration for the comedy part came from the ,fatal string break' incident, which me and my friend still laugh over anytime we remember—the day that tampon string broke off, leaving inside... The particular predicament was as hilarious as it was stressful, and I wanted to capture that bizarre mixture of both feelings and share it with the world ever since. Thus, scene two.

Also, most men in my family cringe, frown, or at best, stay silent at the mention of pads, tampons, period flow, or any other theme from the ,taboo feminine' and maybe because of it I am always more than happy to bring it up—to appreciate the wonder of the natural female body in all its stages and cycles.

The inspiration for the ,dark' to pair with the ,comedy' then came from a completely different set of experiences: working low wage for a heartless, spineless employer who makes all the profit off of your blood, sweat, and tears and tests your patience with every move. Crafting this story was a search to release the repressed anger and simmering frustrations of an individual in such a situation—an employee pushed to their limit and beyond. A raw, impulsive, outof-control quest for revenge.

I believe many will be able to relate. The protagonist's effort to maintain

composure and walk the fine line between self-control and self-assertion is a universal reflection of the challenges faced by many in similar circumstances. She starts out a hero but turns villainous midway, and I really wanted to take the audience for this ride to invite them to let go and vicariously live out their own dark fantasies of retribution through her cathartic act.

The high-contrast and sickly

yellowish-green aesthetic combined with the intense, bloody-dark red was deliberately chosen to underscore these adverse emotions festering in all of us and enhance the overall sickening impression of the film.

Ultimately, this is a story of the universal law of Karma; what goes around comes around! So be kind, don't be sexist, and tip the waiter/waitress.
